

# **COMPULSORY COMPETITIONS**

## **GENERATION GAME (RWS)**

A team of two members 18 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to participate in the above competition. One member will participate in one type of competition and the other member in another type of competition or both will compete in the same competition. Examples of competitions – cooking, craftwork, do-it-yourself job etc. etc. Members will draw lots on the day and will have to participate in the competition they have been allocated. On the Rally day the Judge in the respective section will give a demonstration or give a plan for the member to follow and they in turn will be given a specified time limit – 15 minutes to 1 hour to carry out the task as instructed. If the Judge wishes he/she can tell the competitors what is expected of them during the competition time and he/she will not give a demonstration. Marks allocated – 100 per competitor.

Members to provide: white coats; sharp scissors; chopping, pastry or bread boards; a selection of knives (e.g. vegetable knife, chopping knife, bread knife, round bladed knife); dish cloth; towel; pastry brush; grater; cocktail sticks; 2 sheets greaseproof paper and pencil. Clubs will receive a bill for essential items following the County Rally (approx. £10 each).

The two highest individuals in this competition will be invited to represent the County at the Royal Welsh Show.

## **CLUB DISPLAY (RWS)**

Theme – “The Royal Welsh Show”

Team of up to six members all of whom will be 26 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to stage a display which should depict “The Royal Welsh Show”. Displays to be staged and prepared by a team of not more than four members, plus two additional members who will be permitted to erect the frame only. All members must wear white coats. Space allowed 6’ (1m 82.9cm) high; 6’ (1m 82.9cm) wide; 4’6” (1m 37.1cm) deep – maximum outside measurements. Participating Clubs to be responsible for all labelling, which may be in English only, Welsh only or bilingual. All construction to be made by members. No perishable foods to be used. Competitors are responsible for all items on display.

## **SEDAN CHAIR (RWS)**

A team of five members 26 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003. Four members to carry the Sedan Chair from the North End of the Showring to the South End and to collect the fifth member. The members will then return to the North End with the member sat in the Chair. Each team to submit a written commentary in English or Welsh on their display. Prior to the race one member to give this commentary on their display in the Ring while being judged, for which 2 minutes will be allocated. Copies of commentaries must be received by Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> April 2004 otherwise one penalty mark will be deducted from the team’s overall marks for every day after the 28<sup>th</sup>. One point per 15 seconds or part thereof will be deducted from the overall marks if teams go overtime whilst giving the commentary.
