

# **SECTION C**

## **PONY JUDGING**

A team of two members 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to place and give reasons on two rings of four ponies – Section D.

The competition will be judged on breed points.

During the period of the competition competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than the Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification.

Timing: 15 minutes allowed for inspection and handling.

Reasons: Each competitor will be allowed two minutes to state his/her reasons. Competitors who exceed this time limit will incur penalties at a rate of two marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from the competitor's total.

## **MOUNTAIN BIKE – 1 MEMBER**

One member 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to participate in a mountain bike obstacle course. Care should be taken so that competitors do not knock over or drive over any of the cones/stakes etc. If any fault is incurred on an obstacle, then a penalty of 10 seconds will be added to the competitor's score. Competitors will be timed over the whole course and any penalties added to the final time taken. The winner will be the competitor with the lowest score.

Helmets must be worn for this competition and **MUST BE** supplied by the competitors.

**COMPETITORS SHOULD ALSO SUPPLY THEIR OWN MOUNTAIN BIKE FOR THIS COMPETITION.**

## **COMMERCIAL HAND SHEARING (RWS) – 1 MEMBER**

One member 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to shear two ewes in the commercial style. One time penalty point for every 30 seconds will apply. This class will be run based on the rules applicable to machine shearing. This class will be judged at the RWS by Machine Shearing Judges.

The highest placed individual in this hand shearing competition (junior section **or** senior section) will be invited to represent the County at the Royal Welsh Show.

**COOKERY (RWS)**

Theme – “Celebration”

A team of two members 16 years of age or under on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to prepare and serve a Celebratory Brunch for two suitable for the 2004 100<sup>th</sup> Royal Welsh Show, ideally to be served as an outdoor meal before watching the Cob Judging in the Main Ring. Costs not to exceed £20 in total.

Members may provide and use a gas grill plus small ring, or gas oven plus small ring or two gas rings only. No electrical appliances to be used but battery operated mixers etc may be used.

No cooking to be done beforehand, but ingredients may be weighed and vegetables/fruit washed beforehand. Recipes and costings must be presented. Time allowed – one hour for cooking, to include displaying of meal in the space provided (2ft 3ins x 2ft 3ins x 2ft high) (backing material and accessories may be arranged following the one hour and will be outside of this time). All exhibits to be within the alcove size/space including any drapes or lining, in/on serving dishes/containers (competitors to supply). Accessories that are in harmony with the rest of the exhibit and that are in scale with it and each other, but not dominant, are allowed. Working area: one trestle table including cooker space.

**WOODWORK COMPETITION**

A team of two members (both to be 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003) working as a pair to construct a 3 metre Sheep Hay Rack from plantation thinnings using hand tools only. If so desired competitors may make use of wire netting and/or weld mesh. No preparatory work of any kind will be allowed. Members to supply all materials including timber, and wire/mesh. Time allowed 2 hours.

Marks will be awarded for structural soundness, safe working methods, utilisation of materials etc. Total marks 200.

**“TELL ME, SHOW ME” COMPETITION – 1 MEMBER**

One member 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 to participate in the “Tell me, Show me” part of the Driving test. The candidate will have to demonstrate or answer questions as set by the Judge on Rally day. Car will be supplied by the County Federation and the make will not be disclosed.

Marks 100 per competitor.
